**HAVEN GROUP MEMBERS
DRAW "LIVING TREES"**

The women in the support group for adult survivors of childhood sexual abuse were challenged to draw trees to represent themselves. The "Living Trees" were to be self portraits of their entire lives. They drew the roots to represent all of those who had contributed to their growing up, including those who had sexually abused them, the branches to represent all of the important people in their lives, then fruit, flowers or leaves to represent all that they had experienced, accomplished and were proud of. The women were surprised how full and rich their trees were and how small and insignificant each of them drew the roots of their abuse. The group was happy to discover that each group member included HAVEN as one of their tree branches. One of the group members commented, "HAVEN and this group saved my life" as she showed off her tree.
